learn creatively and optimally through state-of-the-art equipment and e-learning opportunities like online courses and Augmented Reality (AR).


Upon graduation, trainees will receive the highly coveted WSQ Higher Certificate in Food Services (Culinary Arts) and be assisted with job placements in F&B organisations.


HCSA Academy Culinary

### STORIES OF HOPE

My parents divorced when I was a child. After moving from family to family, I was placed with a stepfather who physically abused me and I was hospitalised for a few months.

I was sexually abused on three different occasions and raped by an acquaintance. After getting flashbacks of the incidents, I started to harm myself. I felt suicidal and started drinking to stop the flashbacks. A psychologist later came to my school and referred me to MSF.

" I have decided to focus on my future instead of my past."

Now that I am at Dayspring Residential Treatment Centre, I have decided to focus on my future instead of my past. I hope to work on my relationship with my parents by learning to better understand and communicate with them. My desire is to return home and be reunited with them one day.
